COLORFUL PLACEMATS & COLORFUL CHAINS (Craft)

Discuss the different people groups and skin colors in the world. Help the children see the importance of each race and the need to be tolerant of them all. Cut long strips of red, yellow, black, brown, and white paper. Weave a placemat with the strips of paper. If desirable, children can write, "I am special" on their placemats.

This craft is similar to the placemats. Cut red, yellow, black, brown, and white paper into long strips. Each child will receive several strips of the colored paper. Loop the paper strips to make links in the chain. Then tape or staple the loops to hold them together.
