Patience Craft

BEAUTIFUL BUTTERFLY (Craft, 20 minutes)

After learning about the monarch caterpillar and butterfly, use old crayons and wax paper to make your own beautiful butterfly. Remember that it takes a lot of patience for caterpillars to become what they were meant to be!

Use a cheese grater to shave old crayons into colorful bits and pieces. Iron the shavings between two pieces of wax paper. Cut out the wax paper in the shape of a butterfly (use image below as a template). Make a butterfly's body using construction paper, and glue it to the middle.

Write the word "Patience" on the butterfly. If you're doing this activity as a class, you can write one or two words from the definition or one of the "I Wills" on each butterfly, and hang them in the classroom to form the whole message.

Supplies: Old crayons, cheese grater, wax paper, iron, construction paper, scissors, glue, marker
